<b>3. Objective</b>	The Asifood project is a capacity-building project in the field of higher education involving collaboration among thirteen partners from Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam, Austria, Belgium, Italy, and France.
<b>4. Short Descriptions</b>	The incidence of food-related outbreaks, mainly related to food safety, affects consumers' health, quality of life and national economies, especially in developing countries. In food safety, this is a stringent problem. This project aims to address this globally by training populations, from students to professionals, of private companies and public agencies. This program addresses issues that have not been addressed up to now, such as the necessity to manage food safety in the global food supply chain strategy and in accordance with the ASEAN 2015 objectives, to integrate food safety homogeneously in all the region with internal standards and with the training of international.
<b>5. Output/Social Impact</b>	A postgraduate level curriculum for food safety was developed and implemented. Various teachers and professionals were provided training as part of a capacity-building program. The courses are also developed on e-module and implemented among the consortium partners as well as in Southeast Asia and South Asian countries.
