3. Objective	The project aims to set up to expand scientific collaboration between Europe (EU) and Southeast Asia (SEA) in a more strategic and coherent manner to tackle the societal challenges, especially in food security and safety, water management, and health.

Short Descriptions	SEA-EU-NET will build upon and leverage EU-SEA science and technology relationships developed through past support and coordination actions, to deepen engagement and build momentum in science and technology cooperation. It broadens the scope of EU-ASEAN cooperation through sustainable collaboration. SEA-EU-NET2 focuses on three major societal challenges: food security and safety; water management and health.

Output/Social Impact	The project has an impact on i) a structured and substantiated policy dialogue between ASEAN and the EU; ii) the promotion of the ERA in SEA; iii) the role of the EU as a major partner in research cooperation and innovation by jointly tackling societal challenges; and iv) the development of new funding schemes in research and academic mobility.
