3. Objective	To conduct collaborative research on aquatic species of commercial importance in Thailand, focusing on innovative nutrition and health management.
4. Short Descriptions	Grobest Holdings is a multinational corporation based in Hong Kong and operating in eight major aquaculture-producing countries, specializing in the formulation and manufacture of aquaculture feeds, with a significant presence in the Asia Pacific region. This project has initiated several research trials involving innovative aquafeed formulations and functional feeds while developing a robust infrastructure for intensive shrimp production and research on-campus at AIT.

Output/Social Impact	An international Expert Consultative Workshop was organized, and the final report identified the technological innovations and practices for the reduction of antimicrobial use and mitigation of antimicrobial risk in aquaculture for their wider dissemination in the Asia-Pacific. Project outcomes were also presented at the FAO workshop, TCP/RAS/3702, during World Antimicrobial Awareness Week, November 24–November 30, 2021.
